Scrollsaw Project – Offset Holiday Tree

Material – ¾" wood 10" x 9"

Sawblade – I recommend a 7R or 8R blade

Setup – For all but the outline of the tree, the saw must be set at 5 degrees Left Side down.

## Directions:

- 1. Print the pattern on the next page and either copy with carbon paper or using a removable spray adhesive, attach it to the wood with the grain vertical.
- 2. Note the entry points and angles on the pattern. NOTE: Failure to use this entry point will result in the cut piece setting in instead of out.
- 3. Starting with the small tree in the center, cut out each piece. NOTE: Sharp turns with an offset blade are difficult. They will likely not be sharp. Take your time turning. Hold the wood stable while turning.
- 4. Set the blade to 0 degrees and cut out the tree AND the top segment.
- 5. Reset the blade to 5 Degrees Left Side down and use the entry point marked on the plan to cut the star glow from the tree.
- 6. Sand and remove all burrs.
- 7. Round over the edges by hand. NOTE: The angle of the cut will make a router roundover bit push away from the work.
- 8. Finish as desired.
